

North West REC and Basin Electric Power Cooperative will be sponsoring several scholarships to dependents of members of North West REC in 2021. Last year we awarded \$35,000 in scholarships to 85 students!

There will be two \$1,000 scholarship winners from each of the four districts of North West REC (Ida, O'Brien, Plymouth, and Sioux). The selection process for the \$1,000 scholarship winners will be based on a combination of SAT/ACT scores, overall grade-point average, work experience, participation in school and community activities, a personal statement of career goals, and a written reference or appraisal by a third party.

Scholarship applicants, who are not awarded a \$1,000 scholarship award, will be asked to watch an educational video on North West REC and the cooperative model and then complete a questionnaire. This will then enter applicants into a random drawing for a \$500 or \$250 scholarship. All applicants will receive at least a \$250 scholarship. Details of this video and questionnaire will be communicated at a later date.

North West REC members may qualify if their dependent meets the following

- Must be a U.S. citizen.
- Are current North West REC members.
- Must be a senior in high school for the 2021-2022 school year and planning to enroll in a full-time undergraduate or graduate course of study at an accredited two-year or four-year college, university, or vocational/technical school.
- Submit an application as provided by North West REC.
- Return all completed forms no later than Friday, February 25, 2022.

Approximately 40 high school students are chosen by local electric cooperatives from across the state of lowa every year. The lowa students join with more than 1,800 students from co-ops around the country for the national Youth Tour in Washington D.C. in June.

North West REC is sponsoring the 2022 Youth Tour Contest for two students receiving an ALL-EXPENSE PAID trip to Washington, D.C. The trip is scheduled for July 18-24, 2022, (with orientation the evening of June 18 in Des Moines.)

All sons and daughters of North West REC member consumers, who are presently juniors in high school are eligible to participate. The Board of Directors and management encourage all who are eligible to enter the Youth Tour Contest for an exciting educational experience.

# NORTH WEST REC OFFERS Powerline Scholarship

North West REC is again sponsoring a powerline scholarship. This program is designed to assist persons enrolled in a course of powerline training at Northwest Iowa Community College in Sheldon.

A \$1000 scholarship will be awarded to an individual who has met the eligibility requirements. To be considered for the scholarship, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Reside in the four county area served by North West REC (Ida, Plymouth, O'Brien and Sioux Counties)
- Be a member or the child/dependant of a member of North West REC
- Be accepted as a full time student in the powerline program at Northwest Iowa Community College in Sheldon
- Submit a scholarship application to North West REC by Friday, February 25, 2021

All applicants are required to submit an application form as well as their most recent academic transcript. The criteria for the award will be based upon community and school activities, potential for success and grade point average.

# ELECTRIC APPLIANCES – NEW UNITS INSTALLED ON OUR SYSTEM, MUST BE ENERGY STAR CERTIFIED EACH MEMBER IS LIMITED TO A MAXIMUM OF \$250 PER CALENDAR YEAR IN COMBINED APPLIANCE REBATES.

- Clothes washer \$50 per unit - Freezer \$25 per unit - Dishwasher \$25 per unit

- DRYER \$25 PER UNIT



#### **BUILDING INSULATION**

- BUILDING MUST BE ALL ELECTRIC AS THE PRIMARY HEATING SOURCE WITH ELECTRIC BACKUP
- Must be professionally installed for blown-in, areosheild, spray foam, insulating concrete forms, rigid styrofoam panels and/or structural panel type insulation
- Residential (house) rebate limited to 30% of installed insulation cost up to a maximum rebate of \$800 per building per calendar year
- Commercial/Industrial/Ag buildings rebate limited to 10% of installed insulation cost up to a maximum rebate of \$2,000 per building per calendar year

#### VARIABLE SPEED AND SOFT START MOTORS

- \$30 PER HORSEPOWER NEW ONLY
- COMMERCIAL/INDUSTRIAL/AG BUILDINGS (SEASONAL APPLICATIONS ARE NOT ELIGIBLE)
- Up to a maximum rebate of \$5,000 per motor

Motor rebate program will run until an allotted amount of money runs out. Please call before submitting a rebate to make sure there is money available.

#### "YOU PULL THE PLUG" APPLIANCE DISPOSAL PROGRAM

MEMBER AGREES TO SELF-REMOVE AND RECYCLE QUALIFYING APPLIANCE (REFRIGERATOR OR FREEZER IN WORKING ORDER) VIA AN APPROVED AND CERTIFIED APPLIANCE DE-MANUFACTURER OR DROP-OFF LOCATION.

Member will receive a \$50 rebate, per qualifying recycled appliance, up to three appliances, per calendar year. A dated copy of a receipt by the certified vendor/landfill/recycler must accompany the rebate application form (available from our office or online).

#### ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGERS

- Level 2 Chargers: 2.9kw-17kw, 208-240V
- Must be hardwired and installation must meet local code
- Member required to provide charger make, model, s/n, specifications
- CANNOT BACK-FEED INTO THE SYSTEM
- Residential \$750 per charger, 50% max equipment cost, max 2 chg/house
- Commercial/Industrial/Ag \$1,200 per charger, 50% max equipment cost, max 5 chg/account



Load management is one of the easiest ways for members to become active members in their cooperative and save money on their electric bills. Not only does having a load management switch help qualify you for the interruptible all electric heat rate, it also qualifies you to purchase a Marathon water heater from us at a rebated price! If you look across the page at the water heater

section of our rebates you can the savings you can receive by having a switch! An even bigger bonus, if you are building a new home with all electric heat and have a load management switch installed you can receive \$1,000 rebate on an 85 gallon water heater!

# 2022 Energy Efficiency REBATES

All changes to our energy efficiency rebates are effective as of January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022. We want to make sure all our members are aware of the current rebates. See the full list of rebates we offer below.

Rebate forms for New Electric Appliances, Building Insulation, and Pull the Plug are available at our offices and can also be found on our website at nwrec.coop under the member services tab.

No form is needed for the other rebates, simply submit a copy of the invoice for the rebated equipment to North West REC, and a representative from North West REC will call you to set up a time to inspect the installation prior to the rebate being paid to verify that it has been installed and is operating.
